————— | “Barbara A. Swift received her nomination, for Works, from the Washington Chapter. Her landscape and urban design practice produces designs that engage the context, circumstances, and complex patterns of place—human and natural. Her work ranges from wild-land ecological system restoration to carefully crafted urban projects embedded with subtle reference to history and culture. Her body of work reflects an elegantly minimal aesthetic that responds to the demands of daily life. In 1973, she developed an independent study program in Kyoto, Japan, that focused on traditional landscape architecture and rigorous study of calligraphy and sumi. She established Swift Company in 1982 as a platform for formulating the questions that result in meaningful, progressive, and ecologically pioneering work.” —————
